

Cuyahoga County Pistol League

AWARDS

At the end of each season, all competitors are eligible for awards if they meet all the league qualifications.

FIRST, SECOND and THIRD PLACE AWARDS: are given to the top 3 competitors in each classification.

Classifications are as follows:

Over ALL
High Master
Master
Expert
Sharp Shooter
Marksman
Pro-Marksman

MOST IMPROVED AWARD: is for the competitor that has the most improved score difference from the present season as compared to the previous season.

HIGH WOMAN TROPHY: is for the female competitor scores only and is presented to the female competitor with the highest score in the present season.

CLUB PLAQUES:

Club awards are broken into four separate classes known as: 280, 290, 295 and 300 CLUB AWARD. The Club Award Number represents the lowest average individual match score a competitor needed to win this award. These awards are presented to any competitor that achieves a first time high score equal to or above the club award number. This is a once in a life time award. Any competitor receiving a club award is eligible for the next higher award but never a lower award. If during the season a competitor qualifies for a first time or new award and by the end of the season qualifies for the next higher club award, the competitor only receives an award for the highest club award achieved in the current season. There for a competitor can only receive one club award in a given season.

Special Qualification: The competitor must have league fees paid in full and the match score must be achieved during any Regular Scheduled Team Match or League Makeup matches. Competitor does not have to qualify for awards to achieve a CLUB Plaque.
